The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for seeking direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to take action on the representation dated 07.06.2019 (Annexure P-1) and 27.06.2019 (Annexure P-2) given by the petitioner against respondent No.4.

Matter has been called twice, however, no representation on behalf of the petitioner is made.

Notice of motion was issued to respondents No.2 and 3 on 01.07.2021 pursuant to which a status report dated 03.09.2021 has been filed. As per the report, the matter was investigated and statement of the petitioner herein was recorded. The petitioner has categorically stated that a sum of Rs.1,35,000/- was due and pending towards him from one Surender Singh. However, the matter stands settled before the Panchayat and petitioner would not like any legal action to be taken on the basis of his complaint.

I have heard counsel for the respondent-State and have also

perused the reply filed. As the petitioner has stated that he does not want any action to be taken on his complaint, the instant petition stands dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
