Learned counsel for the petitioners, inter-alia, contends that case of the petitioners is squarely covered by a Full Bench judgment of this Court rendered in *Harbans Lal v. State of Punjab and others (CWP No. 2371 of 2010 decided on 31.08.2010)*. The petitioners also submitted a representation dated 09.03.2021 (Annexure P-6), but the same has not been adverted to by the respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners would be satisfied, at this stage, if a final decision is taken, either way, by the respondents on the pending representation dated 09.03.2021 (Annexure P-6), giving reasons thereof.

3. Notice of motion. Learned State counsel, on advance service, joins proceedings and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the grievance of the petitioners as per pending representation dated 09.03.2021 (Annexure P-6) and also by keeping in view the contentions raised in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from today.

8. Disposed of in above terms.
