Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.121, dated 24.10.2020, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Counsel for the parties have been heard at length and pleadings on record have been perused.

As per prosecution version, present petitioner along with co-accused, Pargat Singh were apprehended on 24.10.2020 and from their conscious possession, 5820 tablets of Lomotil, 450 tablets of Alprazolam and 6 injections of Buprenorphine were recovered.

Such recovery would be construed as commercial in nature.

Keeping in view the bar envisaged under Section 37 of the NDPS Act, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer of the petitioner for

grant of regular bail at this stage.

Petition dismissed.
