Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C, the petitioner seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.169 dated 12.07.2019, registered under Sections 399, 402 IPC and 411 IPC of 1860 and later on Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act was added registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 17.05.2021, passed by this Court, ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submit that in compliance of the order dated 17.05.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner has join the investigation.
