This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent No.1 to allow the petitioner to make withdrawals from his bank account No. 38377334193 from the remaining surplus amount after withholding Rs. 5 lakhs or in the alternate, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the message dated 16.4.2021 (Annexure P-8) from respondent No.3 communicating the closing of the complaint of the petitioner dated 12.4.2021 (Annexure P-7). It is further prayed that respondent No.3 be directed to decide the complaint of the petitioner on merits after giving him a fair hearing and by passing a reasoned order.

A bare perusal of the record shows that the issue of withholding of withdrawals of amounts from the bank account of the petitioner is already pending before a civil Court. The petitioner cannot be permitted to carry on parallel proceedings on the same cause before the civil Court and before the High Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
