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RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (oral)

This petition has been filed by the petitioner praying for a direction to declare that respondent No.6 is ineligible as he does not fulfill the eligibility criteria prescribed in the tender notice issued by the official respondents.

Apparently, the petition is pre-mature and at this stage this Court would not go into the issue of eligibility or ineligibility of any of the tenderers and take a decision in this regard for the tender process is still in progress and the respondent authorities are yet to finalize and award the tender.

Rather, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions from Mr. Sudhir Kumar, Executive Engineer, Public Health Department, submits that the respondent-authority is already examining not only the complaint/representation of the petitioner but the technical viability of all other tenderers is also being evaluated. Therefore, he submits that a final decision shall be taken in the matter only after the said consideration.

In view of the aforesaid statement of the learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana and in view of the fact that the petition filed by the petitioner is pre-mature at this stage, the petition filed by the petitioner is dismissed.
