GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is stated to have been behind bars since the last about 3 years and 10 months and only 8 PWs out of cited 21 PWs have been examined, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial. The trial Court may prepone the matter in case a long date is fixed. The trial Court to make a schedule in advance for recording prosecution evidence and fix 5 or 6 dates in advance or even more during the next month and after examining the list of witnesses, the unexamined PWs be summoned by allocating different dates for their presence. Summons for all the dates fixed in advance be

issued in one go and their service be duly monitored. Efforts be made to conclude recording of prosecution evidence within 4 months.

The Superintendent of Police concerned may also be requested for rendering assistance for securing presence of the remaining PWs.
