By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of the order dated 27.09.2019 (copy Annexure P-6), passed by the learned JMIC, Hathin, District Palwal, as also the order dated 18.03.2021 (copy Annexure P-7), passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Palwal, in case FIR no.191, dated 07.07.2017, registered at Police Station Sahin, District Palwal,(for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 452, 506 of the IPC, with Sections 325 and 326 thereof added subsequently), whereby the petitioners have been summoned to face trial in terms of Section 319 of the Cr.P.C.

After it was pointed out by this court to the learned counsel for the petitioners that in the complaint itself also, the allegation is that all the accused in collusion with each other had attacked the complainant and his companions, he does not wish to press this petition. He, however submits that since obviously the police had given a 'clean chit' to the petitioners and their custodial interrogation is not required, they may be protected as regards

their arrest before the trial court.

Naturally on appearing/surrendering before the trial court, if the petitioners move an application for grant of bail upon arrest, that application would be considered by the trial court on its own merits.

The present petition, on the statement of the counsel for the petitioners, is dismissed as withdrawn.
