The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 491 dated 30.12.2020 registered at Police Station Gannaur, District Sonipat, Haryana under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Section 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations made in the FIR are fanciful and, thus, not believable. No person who is going to commit the murder or cause injury would go with an unloaded rifle and would attempt to load the same in the presence of the entire village.

Learned State counsel was directed to file a copy of the challan and the same has been done by way of status report notarized on 29.05.2021.

A perusal thereof shows that Sukhbir son of Deep Chand as well as Ramphal son of Surat Singh who were joined as independent witnesses by the police in the investigation have denied that such an incident took place. Apart from the aforementioned independent witnesses, the other statements are those of the complainant and interested persons.

In view of the above, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to

be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
