Case is taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is a driver by profession and he solemnized marriage with Ranjana-respondent No.5 on 08.07.2017. It was the third marriage of respondent No.5 with the petitioner. However, because of their temperamental differences, they could not stay together and accordingly, a mutual compromise between them was arrived at on 06.10.2020, which was witnessed by Rakesh Kumar-respondent No.7, who has illicit relations with Rani-respondent No.6, mother of respondent No.5. Despite mutual compromise, a complaint dated 08.04.2021 had been moved by respondent No.5 against the petitioner. It is

further stated that the petitioner has moved a representation dated 26.04.2021 (Annexure P-2) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, but the same has not been decided till date.

As noticed above, the dispute between the parties is purely matrimonial in nature. Hence, this Court does not find any justified cause to issue any direction, much less the directions prayed for in the present petition.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
