Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.51 dated 15.3.2021, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural.

On 12.5.2021 notice of motion was issued and arrest of the petitioner was stayed. It was contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the cheque of Rs.6,10,000/- was issued in favour of complainant to help his younger brother Jasbir Singh. To show his bonafide the petitioner offered to deposit Rs.2,00,000/- before the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petitioner deposited Rs.2,00,000/- on 9.7.2021. The complainant was impleaded as party. *In spite of* service, none had put in appearance on behalf of complainant on the last date. The same is the position for today.

On 23.8.2021 the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instruction from ASI Angrej Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is co-operating.

In view of above noted facts, the interim relief granted to petitioner is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
