Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.241 dated 26.11.2020 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case and that no injury has been attributed to him. It is also submitted there is no other case pending or registered against the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He submits that the recovered pistol allegedly used in the offence, was purchased by Mohit from the petitioner. The said pistol had been handed over by Mohit to Abhi, brother of the petitioner, who had fired 4-5 shots, which landed on left side of neck and right thigh of the complainant.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

As noticed above, the pistol was allegedly purchased from the petitioner. There is no dispute regarding the injuries caused with the said weapon of offence. As such, the complicity of the petitioner with the other co-accused cannot be ruled out. Hence, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required to unearth the actual chain of events.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
