This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondents no. 2 and 3, to take necessary legal action on the representation, dated 07.05.2021 (copy Annexure P-4) to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents no. 4 to 9 and not to interfere in their personal lives at the behest of the aforesaid respondents.

On 05.07.2021, i.e. the day before yesterday, the following order had been passed by this court:-

*“Case heard via video conferencing.*

*The reply filed on behalf of the respondent-State by the Assistant Superintendent of Police, Samalkha, dated 25.06.2021, is ordered to be taken on record.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioners would take instructions as to when petitioner no. 2 was taken away forcibly by her father (as is contended by learned counsel appearing for the petitioners), because in the*

*affidavit of the Assistant Superintendent of Police, it has been specifically stated that both the petitioners got recorded their statements to the effect that they do not apprehend any threat to their lives, though of course it has also been stated that an FIR has been registered at the instance of the father of petitioner no. 2 at a Police Station in Jabalpur (Madhya Pradesh), with her further contended to have stated (as per the affidavit) that she would be making a statement before the concerned court in Jabalpur.*

*Adjourned to 07.07.2021 ”*

Today, learned counsel submits that the petitioners no longer wish to pursue with the petition as a settlement has been reached between them and respondents no. 4 to 9.

On his statement, the petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
