The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This is a petition seeking anticipatory bail in case of FIR No. 84 dated 20.5.2020 under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Siwan District Kaithal.

There are allegations with regard to forgery availing loan twice on the same land and selling the land on the basis of forged NOC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is 80 years old and is a diabetic patient.

After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition. A prayer is made that the petitioner would surrender within two weeks and applies for regular bail.

Let the Court concerned decide the bail application expeditiously.

The petition is disposed of as not pressed. In case the petitioner surrenders within two weeks from today and applies for regular bail, the Court concerned shall take up the regular bail application immediately. Considering the age of the petitioner and the contention with regard to his medical condition, it is expected that the Court concerned shall make every endeavour to decide the application expeditiously but not later than 10 days from the date of filing of the application.
