Learned State counsel on instructions from police official Sukhwinder Kumar, Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar submits that in consequence of earlier interim orders dated 28.06.2021 and 23.08.2021, the petitioner has since joined the investigation even after addition of offences and he has no objections if the interim orders *interse* are made absolute.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim orders dated 28.06.2021 and 23.08.2021 are made absolute till submission of report under

Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
