This is 5th petition for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.75 dated 09.03.2018, registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act at Police Station Division No.7, District Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel submits that only one more witness is required to be examined and seeks a short accommodation to await the progress of the trial.

In the premise trial Court to not grant unnecessary adjournments given the petitioner has already been in confinement for 3 years and 7 months. Prosecution shall also take appropriate steps to ensure that its only witness left is produced on the next date of hearing for examination.

At this stage, in view of the aforesaid observations made by this Court, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that bail petition be dismissed.
