The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to official respondents No.1 to 3 to grant police protection to the petitioner and her minor daughter as they apprehend danger from the private respondents.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is the wife of respondent No.4 and she has been constantly harassed and ill treated by her husband and private respondents. She has submitted a representation dated 22.02.2021, Annexure P-1, to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (respondent No.2), seeking protection.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the concerned official respondent is directed to look into the representation, Annexure P-1.

Without examining or commenting upon the allegations levelled in the writ petition or in the representation submitted by the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar-respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 22.02.2021, Annexure P-1, and to take suitable action thereon as warranted, in accordance with law.

A copy of the petition alongwith the representation be sent to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, in order to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
