After arguing for some time, learned counsel representing the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition, particularly, in view of the statement of Sh. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh, that the petitioner is also an accused in FIR No. 386 dated 13.12.2020 registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914. Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner would surrender before the trial court within one week from today and will apply for bail.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, if the petitioner surrenders before the trial court within one week from today and makes an application for bail, the same shall be decided by the trial court within one week thereafter.
