This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.111 dated 19.4.2021, registered under Sections 148, 149, 224, 225, 332, 353 and 506 IPC, at Police Station Partap Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Reply filed by the State is taken on record.

A bare perusal of the FIR shows that the incident involves attack upon the police persons when the later were on their official duties. In this alleged attack there is one injury suffered by Head Constable Bhupinder Singh. That injury is attributed to the petitioner. The investigation is at its initial stage and if the petitioner is protected against his arrest at the initial stage, then it will hamper the free and fair investigation. The police might have to recover the weapon of offence from the petitioner by knowing the whereabouts of the same. For that purpose, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner might be considered imperative by the police.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
