This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to ensure protection of the life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Counsel has been heard.

Pleaded case is that petitioner No.2 was already married with one Tannu daughter of Salim. However, petitioner No.2, has now entered into a live-in relationship with petitioner No.1. It has further been asserted that the legally wedded wife namely Tannu is aware of the live-in relationship between the petitioners and does not object to the same.

Pleadings on record as regards the threat perception are utterly vague. This Court has even perused the representation/request

dated 24.04.2021 made by the petitioners herein and addressed to the Superintendent of Police, Yamunanager (Annexure P-3) seeking protection. Even in such representation the relevant averments with regard to the threat perception are in the following terms:-

“There is every possibility that the parents and relatives of both of us will try to attack on us or implicate us in any false case”.

Pleadings on record are wholly insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

No intervention as such is warranted.

Petition dismissed.
