This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.134 dated 15.04.2017 under Section 13 (2) Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Samvardhan Act, 2015, registered at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh. The petitioner apprehend his arrest at the hands of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 18.05.2021, whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel has argued that though the petitioner is named in the FIR, but no substantive role has been attributed to him in respect of the

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alleged commission of an offence. It is pointed out that the petitioner was not aware of the case proceedings against him, therefore, he never applied for bail. Learned counsel further submitted that though the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender on 07.02.2018, however, even this order was not in his knowledge. According to learned counsel, the custody of the petitioner may not serve any useful purpose, as he is ready to join the trial proceedings.

Notice of motion for 11.10.2021.

The petitioner shall appear before the learned trial Court on or before 25.05.2021 and upon his appearance, he shall be admitted on interim regular bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of that Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in deference to the said order, the petitioner appeared before the trial Court, who has been admitted on regular bail vide order dated 21.05.2021. A copy of the order dated 21.05.2021 has been produced.

The above position is not disputed by the learned State counsel, who is assisted by SI Bilasa Ram.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and it is ordered that the petitioner shall remain on regular bail on the basis of same bail bonds/surety bonds furnished by him before the trial Court on 21.05.2021.
