JAISHREE THAKUR J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for seeking direction to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 13.03.2020 (Annexure P-1) given by the petitioner.

2. It is contended that the petitioner has given a representation (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2 and 3 alleging that one Gagandeep Singh had enticed away her daughter, who is a minor, on the pretext of marriage. It is further alleged that Gagandeep Singh and daughter of the petitioner had approached this Hon'ble Court by way of filing a Criminal Writ Petition bearing No.376 of 2020 for seeking protection of life and liberty from the petitioner herein and her family members and this High Court vide order dated 13.01.2020 had directed the official respondents therein to take appropriate steps to ensure the life and liberty of said petitioners in case the apprehension as alleged is found real. It is submitted that daughter of the

petitioner was a minor at the time of her marriage and this fact was not disclosed to the High Court.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

4. Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to take a decision on the representation dated 13.03.2020 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
