The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.042 dated 05.03.2021 under Sections 409 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Vairo Ke, District Fazilka (Annexure P-1).

After arguing for some time and realizing that the Court is not inclined to agree with his submissions, counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to pursue the present petition. He submits that the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and the trial Court be directed to dispose of his regular bail, in case, he chooses to file one, in a time bound manner.

In case, the petitioner surrenders within a period of 10 days from today and files a petition seeking regular bail, the trial Court shall make an endeavour and dispose of the same within a period of one week of its filing.

Petition is disposed of.
