Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.36 dated 31.03.2021 registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (hereinafter to be referred as “the Act of 1985”), at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, no recovery has been effected from the petitioner and the petitioner has been involved only on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused from whom the recovery has been made.

Notice of motion.

On advance notice, Mr. Saurav Khurana, DAG, Punjab appears

and accepts notice on behalf of the State and states that there are as many as 12 other cases against the petitioner, out of which 4 cases are under the Act of 1985.

Having regard to the abovesaid fact that the petitioner is involved in several other cases including four cases under the Act of 1985, this Court is not inclined to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
