Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.560 dated 28.05.2019, under Sections 224, 225, 307, 120-B and 34 IPC and Section 25-54-59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that the accused had got an under-trial released from police custody. He further contends that only one injury on the leg of the police official is attributed to co-accused Ankush. The petitioner, who is 20 years of age, is in custody for over 01 year and 08 months.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Lakhbir Singh states that the challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined as yet. He also contends that the petitioner is also involved in other cases.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner, who is 20 years of age, is in custody for over 01 year and 08 months, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the Police Station Sadar, District Karnal on every alternate Monday till the conclusion of the trial. He shall also furnish his mobile number to the SHO of the concerned police station and keep the location of his phone on.
