Main Case

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.48 dated 17.04.2021 registered under Section 61 of The Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur, Annexure P-1.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

The petitioner is involved in three other cases, details of which are as under:-

A perusal of the above chart shows that all the three cases have been registered against the petitioner under the provisions of the Punjab Excise Act and he stands convicted in one case. Relief of anticipatory bail is not meant for a person, who has a criminal past.

No ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail.

Petition stands dismissed.
