Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.30 dated 15.04.2021, under Sections 376(2)(n), 313 IPC, at Police Station Women Police Station Rohtak, Haryana.

Vide order dated 18.05.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of order dated 18.05.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has fully cooperated with the Investigating Agency and as such, his interim bail be confirmed.

Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana for the State, at the outset, on instructions from ASI Neelam, informs the Court that in pursuance to the same, petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposes the contentions raised by counsel for the petitioner and submits that there are serious allegations against the petitioner.

Though, learned counsel for the complainant has denied the contentions raised by counsel for the petitioner, but in view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the interim order dated 18.05.2021, is made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
