GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.65 dated 12.04.2021 at Police Station City malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 453/323/34 IPC.
2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion on 18.05.2021, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case where a simple injury is alleged to have been caused to the complainant and in fact the FIR was lodged after 15 days of the occurrence, which would clearly show that the same has been lodged after deliberations.

Notice of motion for 21.9.2021.

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3. Learned State counsel has not disputed the fact that it is a case of causing simple injury only. It has been informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation and that he is not wanted in any other case.
4. In view of the aforestated position especially the fact that only a simple injury is attributed to the petitioner and that he has already joined investigation and has a clean record, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 18.05.2021 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
