1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for willful disobedience and non-compliance of order Annexure P/1 dated 29.01.2021 in CWP-2042-2021.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 29.01.2021 in CWP-2042-2021, the respondent has passed order dated 11.05.2021, therefore, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 11.05.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of order dated 11.05.2021, having been passed by the respondent in compliance of order dated 29.01.2021 in CWP-2042-2021, there is sufficient compliance of order of the writ Court, therefore, no action

is called for under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 against the respondent. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 11.05.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
