The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.75 dated 08.03.2021 under Sections 380, 457 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that there is a delay of 17 days in registering the FIR wherein it is alleged that ₹1800/- and alcohol was allegedly stolen by the petitioners. He also contends that the petitioners are in their early 20s' and are in custody for over 2 ½ months.

Learned State counsel upon instructions Head Constable Sawinder, contends that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined. He also contends that the petitioners are involved in other cases.

Heard through video-conferencing.

In view of the above especially when the petitioners are in their early 20s', they are in custody for about 2 ½ months, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, the petitioners shall appear before the Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind on every alternate Monday. They shall also furnish their mobile numbers to the concerned SHO and shall keep the location of their phones on till the conclusion of the trial.
