The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.59 dated 19.02.2021, under Sections 380 and 457 IPC registered at Police Station Narwana, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that two gas cylinders, batteries and ₹4,000/- cash from the cashbox of the shop had been stolen. He further contends that after the registration of instant FIR, the petitioners were also involved in another case. The petitioners are in custody for over four months and prior to registration of the instant FIR, they were not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Head Constable Satyawan states that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined so far.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the above especially when the petitioners are in custody for over four months, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
