GURVINDER SINGH GILL J.(Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.375 dated 02.12.2015, under Sections 120-B, 406, 420 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Kaithal, District Kaithal and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 24.11.2020, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaithal, has been

received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioner Satbir and also of complainant Ram Kumar have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Ram Kumar in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.

5. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaithal has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion and undue influence.

6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.375 dated 02.12.2015, under Sections 120-B, 406, 420 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Kaithal, District Kaithal and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioner.

7. The petitioner would however be at liberty to file a separate fresh petition so as to challenge the order dated 16.11.2018, whereby he was declared proclaimed offender, if he so desires.
