The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.16 dated 09.01.2021, under Sections 323 and 506 IPC read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that co-accused had attacked the complainant and simple injuries were caused in the occurrence.

This Court, by order dated 18.05.2021 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Rakesh Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

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In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 18.05.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
