Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.363 dated 25.12.2020, under Sections 22 (C) /61/85 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although it is alleged that intoxicant tablets were allegedly recovered from the petitioner but the recovered substance is neither a narcotic drug nor a psychotropic substance and, therefore, does not fall under the NDPS Act. He is in custody for over 6 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Amarjeet Singh, contends that the recovered substance is not covered under the NDPS Act.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the recovered substance does not fall under the NDPS Act, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
