The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the petitioner, in case FIR No.382 dated 06.09.2020, registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 341, 506 of the IPC, 1860 Section 25 of Arms Act 1959 (later on Sections 324, 326, 364 of the IPC and Section 54 of Arms Act, 1959 have been added), registered at Police Station Kurukshetra University, District Kurukshetra.

2. The petitioner was arrested on 08.10.2020 and has remained in detention thereafter.

3. In the meantime, investigation against him has already been completed and Challan submitted.

4. Co-accused, namely Kartik has already been granted bail by this Court in CRR No.20 of 2021 on 18.01.2021 and co-accused Mohit

@ Mudit was similarly granted Regular Bail by this Court in

CRM-M-5094-2021 on 19.02.2021.

5. In the given circumstances, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period at this stage is not called for on account of the fact that the trial is likely to take its own considerable time to conclude due to ongoing Covid-19 pandemic. As such, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
