1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0055 dated 21.02.2021 registered under Sections 380, 457, 447, 511, 506, 34 IPC and 1860 and 436 IPC added later on vide GD No.021 dated 21.02.2021 at Police Station Division-B, District Police, Commissionerate Amritsar.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order dated 19.05.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned State Counsel on instruction from ASI Devinder Singh confirms that pursuant to the order dated 19.05.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the same, was released on ad-interim

pre-arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of learned state counsel, order dated 19.05.2021 is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. However, nothing stated hereinabove shall be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
