The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is the petition filed by the wife under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking the transfer of proceedings in petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing no. HMA 227/2020 titled as 'Jatinder Singh vs. Daljit Kaur' pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Tarn Taran, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Amritsar.

The petitioner claims that presently she is residing with her parents at Amritsar. She further claims that she cannot properly defend the petition at Tarn Taran as she does not have any independent source of income.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent (husband) is already defending two cases at Amritsar i.e a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C and a complaint under Section 406, 498-A IPC.

As per the office report, the respondent has been served,

however, he remains un-represented.

In view of the aforesaid uncontroverted facts, the transfer application is allowed. It is directed that the proceedings in petition filed Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing no. HMA 227/2020 titled as 'Jatinder Singh vs. Daljit Kaur' pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Tarn Taran, be transferred to the court of competent jurisdiction at Amritsar. The transferor court is directed to remit the file of the case to the transferee court forthwith. The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the District & Sessions Judge, Amritsar on 03.11.2021, who shall either try the case himself or assign the same to the court of competent jurisdiction in the District.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
