This application is for placing on record copy of order dated 17.09.2021 and compromise deed dated 09.09.2021 as Annexures P-3 and P-4.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and copy of the order dated 17.09.2021 and compromise deed dated 09.09.2021 is taken on record as Annexures P-3 and P-4.

Main Case

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.22 dated 25.02.2021 under Section 379-B IPC (Sections 201, 411, 120-B IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Zira, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged by the complainant that two persons on a motorcycle had snatched a bag containing Rs.2,50,000/- in cash and cheques amounting to Rs.4,70,000/-. However, after

four days of the occurrence, the complainant had stated in his supplementary

statement that the bag contained Rs.4,70,000/- in cash and cheques amounting to Rs.2,50,000/-. The petitioner was named in the supplementary statement of the complainant. The petitioner is in custody for over 09 months. She further contends that the matter has been compromised with the complainant. A copy of the compromise is annexed as Annexure P-4. Co-accused namely Gursewak Singh has been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-37745-2021 on 17.09.2021.

Learned State counsel states that recovery of money has been effected from the petitioner. The petitioner is also involved in several other cases. She further states that charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 09 months, co-accused has been granted bail, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
