Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.18 dated 06.03.2021, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in terms of the order dated 04.06.2021, an amount of Rs. 9 lakhs/- was deposited with the Investigating Officer which has been further handed over to the complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant acknowledged that the complainant has received Rs. 9 lakhs.

However, it is mutually agreed between the parties that an amount of Rs. 9 lakhs deposited by the petitioner and received by

the complainant would abide by the result of the trial.

Vide order dated 04.06.2021, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

On instructions, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 04.06.2021 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
