AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the appellants, after arguing for some time, prays for withdrawal of the present appeal with liberty to approach the High Court of Himachal Pradesh for the same grievance as was highlighted by the appellants in Criminal Writ Petition No.4024 of 2021, titled as 'Sahil & another Vs. U.T. Chandigarh & others'. He further prays that the costs as has been imposed by the learned Single Judge while passing the order dated 28.04.2021 may be waived.

Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the appellants and keeping in view the fact that the appellants

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are permanent residents of Himachal Pradesh and the private respondents are also residents of Himachal Pradesh, the prayer of the counsel for the appellants is accepted. The Criminal Writ Petition No.4024 of 2021 preferred by the appellants is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to approach the High Court of Himachal Pradesh for the redressal of the grievance as was highlighted by them in the said writ petition. The costs as imposed by the learned Single Judge vide order dated 28.04.2021 is ordered to be waived in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case.
