The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.174 dated
21.10.2019, registered under Sections 324, 147, 148, 159, 506 IPC
(Section 326 IPC added lateron), at Police Station Maloya Chandigarh.

At the outset, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI

Jagpal Singh, has stated that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court on 19.05.2021 and 09.08.2021, petitioner No.1 Shankar and petitioner No.2 Arun Kumar alias Dabbu have surrendered before the trial Court on 20.07.2021 and 25.05.2021 respectively and have been granted interim bail. He has further submitted that even the challan has been presented and the investigation is complete. Learned State counsel has also submitted that he has no objection in case the interim order dated 19.05.2021 passed by this Court is confirmed.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The orders dated 19.05.2021 and 09.08.2021, are made absolute.
