Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the job of the Data Entry Operator has been outsourced by the Market Committee U.T., Chandigarh and the contract has been given to M/s Shine & Sind Security Solutions Pvt. Ltd. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner has been chosen by the said agency to discharge the services and his name has already been recommended to the Administrator of the Market Committee and the petitioner has also submitted a joining report, which is not being accepted. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has also filed a representation dated 12.04.2021 (Annexure P-3)

with the Deputy Commissioner raising the said grievance and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to decide his claim with regard to the joining to the post of Data Entry Operator on being recommended by the outsourcing agency i.e. M/s Shine & Sind Security Solutions Pvt. Ltd.

Ms. Aakanksha Sawhney, learned Additional Standing Counsel for U.T., Chandigarh, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that appropriate order on the representation of the petitioner dated 12.04.2021 (Annexure P-3) will be passed by the Administrator and the outcome of the same will be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of one month from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, his grievance stands redressed at this stage and he does not wish to press this petition any further and the same may be disposed of as such.
