Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for releasing the detenué, namely, Salma aged 29 years and her son aged about 4 years from the illegal custody of respondents No. 5 to 10.

2. Learned State counsel, on Court query submits that Station House Officer, Hassanpur, who is the concerned officer of the territorial jurisdiction has made preliminary inquiry and intimated Station House Officer, Tauru, who has wrongly been made a party that the detenué has gone away on her own free volition as she was feeling threatened and harassed at

the hands of her husband owing to the matrimonial dispute between her and her husband.

3. While on the other hand, learned counsel appearing for the detenue/intervener, on advance knowledge of the petition submits that this petition has been filed by the father of the detenue, at the instance of her husband and in-laws, only to harass the detenue to compel her to come back to her matrimonial home where she is under constant threat to her life at the hands of her husband and her in-laws and, therefore, is complete abuse of process of this Court.

4. Having heard respective learned counsels and also in view of the report given by the Station House Officer, Hassanpur to the Station House Officer, Tauru, no grounds are made out to interfere.

5. Dismissed.
