Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.158 dated 07.04.2021, under Sections 21(b) and 27A of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. He has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused from whom 50 grams of heroin was allegedly recovered (noncommercial quantity). He also contends that besides the statement of coaccused, there is no other material which would connect the petitioner to the commission of offence.

This Court, by the order dated 29.07.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 29.07.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
