Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.27 dated 28.03.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur.

Vide order dated 21.05.2021 passed by this Court, the present petition has been disposed of as having been rendered infructuous qua petitioner No.1-Aniket.

Vide order of the even date, petitioner No.2-Deepak Kumar alias Deepak was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Gurvinder Singh, submits that petitioner No.2 has joined the investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 21.05.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner No.2, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
