The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from danger at the hands of respondents No.5 to 9.

Supplementary affidavit of Sh. Ramandeep Singh Bhullar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Khadoor Sahib, Camp at Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has been filed in the Registry which is taken on record. As per the affidavit, respondents No.5-Sukhdev Singh and respondent No. 9-Jagtar Singh have been arrested by the police, respondents No.6 to 8 have been declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 13.08.2020 passed by the Trial Court. During his judicial confinement respondent No.9-Jagtar Singh had died on 21.08.2020. The threat perception of the petitioner and her family has been verified by the local police and

it is found that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
