Main case

Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the

Learned Senior counsel, on instructions submits that the impugned order has been withdrawn by the competent authority; therefore, substantially, the present writ petition is rendered infructuous.

However, he seeks liberty to take recourse to the remedy under law in view of the fact that petitioner remained under suspension for a period of 04 years.
