This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.187 dated 06.05.2020 under Sections 51(b) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 , under Sections 188 and 269 of the IPC and under Section 21(b) of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station, City Tohana District Fatehabad, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the police party apprehended a lady, who was driving a scooter and a male person was riding pillion. On disclosure, she informed her name as Kuldeep Kaur wife of Kala Puri (present petitioner) and the petitioner was accompanying her. After giving notice under Section 50 of the NDPS Act, recovery of 42 grams of heroin was effected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner is involved in some other cases under the NDPS Act, however, he is on bail in those cases and the recovery effected in the present case is of non-commercial quantity. It is further submitted that petitioner is in judicial custody since 06.05.2020.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate in the Court today, according to which, the petitioner, apart from the present case, is involved in four more FIRs under the NDPS Act.

Faced with the same, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
