The petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.133 dated 22.06.2020, under Sections 307, 452, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Badli, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had fired a solitary shot with a pistol which hit the stomach of the injured. The injured has fully recovered from the injury. He also contends that the petitioner is 21 year of age and is in custody for over one year and five months. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents.

Learned State counsel upon instructions states that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined so far. She, however, contends that in view of the serious allegations against the petitioner, he is not entitled to the concession of regular bail,

Heard.

In view of the above especially when the petitioner is 21 year of age, he is in custody for over one year and five months, he is not involved in

any other case, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely

to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
