The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 17 dated 18.03.2021 under Sections 61, 1, 14 of the Excise Act, 1914, P.S. Valtaha, District Tarn Taran.

A perusal of the FIR would go on to show that recovery was made from the house of the petitioner on the basis of secret information. The same is in the nature of a working still which was cooled down alongwith 10 bottles of distilled illicit liquor alongwith 150 kgs of Lahan attached with it. 2 drums of 200 kgs each and one drum of 100 kgs were also recovered from the spot with Lahan. The petitioner was identified by the ASI.

In such circumstances, it is not a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. Accordingly the present petition is dismissed.
